Bay Club Pool Rules

As we approach the spring and summer seasons, we would like to remind you of the pool rules at Bay Club. Please follow the guidelines set forth by DHEC.

- 1. There should be no solo swimming.
- 2. There should be no running, boisterous or rough play.
- 3. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
- 4. There should be no spitting or blowing nose in pool.
- 5. Persons with diarrheal illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
- 6. Persons with skin, eye, ear, or any infections should not enter the pool.
- 7. Persons with open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool.
- 8. Absolutely no animals or pets within the fenced pool area.
- 9. No glass allowed in the pool area or on the deck.
- 10. No children should be in the pool without supervision.
- 11. You should take a shower before entering the pool.

Failure to follow these rules can result in DHEC closing our pool as well as fining the Association. Please help our Association by supporting the rules and regulations of the Bay Club POA. If you witness any pool rule being violated, please do not hesitate to report the violator to the Association. **Violators of pool rules can be fined up to \$100 per occurrence.** Also, if the key is lost, a \$25.00 charge per key will be assessed for replacement.

The facilities at Bay Club Sea Lofts are maintained for the enjoyment of home owners and their guests. Signs are posted to this effect and this rule can be enforced by the Mt. Pleasant Police Department. If you observe unauthorized persons using the pool, you may point out to them that the facility is for residents and guests only. If you are not comfortable with direct interface with the violator, then you can call the Mt. Pleasant Police and they can address the issue. If the Mt. Pleasant Police determine the individual to be in violation of our rules, the violator will receive a permanent posting resulting in arrest upon second offense.

Please do your part to minimize our regime fees. It is the responsibility of each person using the restrooms and fitness room to insure the light/fan switch is turned off and the door locked upon exit. Running the lights and fans all day and all night will definitely increase our power requirements.
