Sunday through Saturday
March 31st through September 30th
Sunrise to Sunset

- Premises are monitored by surveillance cameras.
- Only residents with an active pool pass will be allowed on the premises. Those who enter without an active pass will be considered trespassing.
- Residents whom are 21 years of age and under may only have 1 guest at the pool.
- Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by any person 21 and older.
- Propping the pool gate open is prohibited.
- Umbrellas must be closed when leaving.
- Glass containers of any kind will not be allowed within the gates. All coolers will be subject to inspection. Coolers that contain glass will not be allowed inside the pool area. If a glass bottle is broken, the entire pool must be drained and the offending party will be financially responsible for the cost associated with cleaning and refilling the pool.
- Proper ID must be present if drinking alcohol.
- The pool is a NON-SMOKING facility; Smoking is only permitted outside of the gate(s) in designated smoking areas.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult while in restrooms.
- No loud music, only personal listening devices with headphones are permitted.
- Drinking, eating, and chewing gum are not permitted while in the pool.
- Pets are not permitted within the gate(s) or in the pool.
- Those wearing street clothes or disposable diapers are not permitted in the pool
- Children must wear a swim diaper and bathing suit in the pool.
- Parties and reservations (even approved) should note that this facility is owned by the POA and there will be no exclusive use of the facilities.
- Please respect your community and other homeowners by cleaning up after yourself and guests prior to leaving the facility.
- Running, rough play, pushing, acrobatics, dunking, wrestling, splashing, yelling, diving or jumping haphazardly, snapping of towels, improper conduct causing undue disturbances, including abusive or profane language, on or about the pool area or any acts which would endanger any patron are prohibited.
- Any acts of vandalism or damage to community property will be prosecuted to the maximum extent of the law.
- Those who refuse to obey these rules may have their pool access revoked.
- Unauthorized residents or guests may not loiter or trespass on these premises.
- The Berkeley County Police Department has jurisdiction over these premises.
